The delegates to the 39th IBEW International Convention held in 2016 authorized a Per Capita payment increase to be paid to the International Office. Accordingly, effective Jan. 1, 2018, all dues payments covering Jan. 2018 through Dec. 2018 will increase three dollars (\$3.00) per quarter.

Dues Payments for 2018 will be \$112.50 per quarter. You can pay either: 1 quarter (3 months) \$112.50

½ year (6 months) \$225.00 3/4 year (9 months) \$337.50 full year (12 months) \$450.00

Dues are to be paid quarterly in advance according to the Local # 43 By-Laws.

During Open Enrollment, you may elect coverage, change coverage, opt-out of coverage, or add an eligible dependent.

An Open Enrollment packet will be mailed to your home prior to November 1, 2017.

If you fail to make your changes on or before November 30, 2017 your next opportunity to do so will be during the next Open Enrollment period in November 2018.

In our current contract - Section 2.19 Tool List - it states "In addition, Journeymen shall be responsible to have verifiable 'OSHA-10' training and CPR Certified Training." Please call the JATC (315-546-0221) to see when the next scheduled classes are, if you need either of these training sessions.

OSHA-10 and CPR training are needed to work in Local 43's jurisdiction as a Journeyman.
