### \*New\* Union Dues for 2016

Amendments to Article IX of the IBEW Constitution, approved at the 38<sup>th</sup> IBEW International Convention, state that all dues payments covering January 2016 to December 2016 will increase three dollars (\$3.00) per quarter. Therefore, dues payments for 2016 will be **\$103.50 per quarter**, due and payable during the first month of each quarter.

You can also pay ahead either:

1 Quarter (3 Months)	=	\$ 103.50
½ Year (6 Months)	=	\$ 207.00
¾ Year (9 Months)	=	\$ 310.50
Full Year (12 Months)	=	\$ 414.00
